

What do I need to do to be officially registered for a trip?

You will need to complete the online application, complete the travel forms and pay your trip deposit.

Do I need a passport to travel on my trip?

If you are leaving the United States, you will need a passport which has an expiration date 6 months beyond the travel date of your trip.

What are the requirements for me to travel on a mission trip?

You must first regularly attend our Community Changers Outreach at the campus where you attend. You must also have completed the First Step Class hosted by your campus. You must also attend all of the scheduled Mission Team Meetings.

Do I need vaccinations for traveling on my trip?

Does Grace Family Church subsidize the cost of the trip?

No, we assist in training you to raise support and reach out to family and friends for support, and seeking God's guidance.

What happens to my funds if I decide not to go on my trip?

You will lose your deposit and any funds that were donated to your trip from others. Any funds that you personally paid will be given back to you if it does not jeopardize the trip for others, then all funds would be non-refundable.
